SUNDAY WORSHIP

OUR SERVICE

Our service is for people of all ages. We worship together through singing, prayers, Bible readings, and hearing the living Word proclaimed

BABY AREA

There are mats, toys and comfy feeding chairs up the back of the auditorium for parents to go with their babies during the service. There are change tables available in the women's and men's bathrooms

TODDLER CRECHE

For children from 18 months to 3 years old with toys, snack time, outdoor play and Bible stories. Parents must sign their kids in and out. You are also welcome to worship as a family in our service if you choose

KIDS CREW GROUPS

We run a Kinder, Prep and Grade 1 program, a Grades 2, 3, and 4 program, and a Grades 5 and 6 program during Term time. The kids learn about the Bible through games, stories, crafts, music and fun

YOUTH GROUP

Youth Group is for youth in Grades 7 to 12 and is run on Thursday nights during Term time. There is engaging and age-specific teaching times, fun games and plenty of opportunities for your kids to grow in their faith and build meaningful relationships
